In this edition with two new offers: an intermediate course and courses being taught in Vigo (coastal Galicia) and Allariz (inner Galicia), so students may have a more complete knowledge of our social, natural and cultural reality.

Course price: 90 €

25 scholarships of 450 € each will be given to those students with the best academic records.

The trips and the transfer Vigo-Allariz will be provided by the organization.

Place of the two courses

From the 3rd to the 15th July: Faculty of Philology and Translation (Campus of Vigo).

From the 16th to the 27th July: Instituto de Allariz (rúa de Pardo Bazán s/n, Allariz).

A selection of 20 students (plus substitutes) will be done in the basic level course taking into account the pre-registered students. These students will have to do the registration in the dates we will indicate them. If one of this 20 students drops the course, the list will move to the next one. The best 15 curricula will obtain each the 450€ scholarship.

With the pre-registered students in the intermediate level course a selection of 15 students (including substitutes) will be done. They will have to do the registration in the dates we will indicate them. If one of this 15 students drops the course, the list will move to the next one. The best 10 curricula will obtain each the 450 € scholarships. To register in the intermediate course it is necessary to have first the certificate of basic course or a similar certificate (CELGA-1, Beginning, Basic, Extensión Cultural, etc.) validated by the Xunta de Galicia.

Registration: from the 30th April to the 30th May 2008

Students will be only registered if they have paid the academic fees (90 €) in the bank account number provided by the University of Vigo. We will provide registered people with detailed information regarding travel, reception etc. We will send them suggestions and information about accommodation etc.

Official certificate

Students that pass the basic or intermediate courses will obtain an official certificate of basic or intermediate knowledge of Galician language issued by the "Secretaría Xeral de Política Lingüística de Xunta de Galicia".
