RO GALATIO1:

Students: The sending institution should send a nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, period of study) to the International Relations Office/Erasmus (bianca.chiosa@ugal.ro) prior to the nomination deadline. An invitation will be released upon home university request.

Students must arrive at least 3 days before the academic year/semester starts, but not during the weekends.

Students in Bachelor and Master study programs are allowed to attend courses of maximum 63 credits/academic year and 33 credits/semester.

Staff: Teaching and non-teaching staff should send (dan.scarpete@ugal.ro) their Teaching or Training Programme prior to their arrival at the University "Dunarea de Jos" of Galati. An invitation will be released upon staff request.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 8 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict".

RO GALATIO1:

Students from the European Union, the European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland do not need a visa or residence permit to enter Romania. Within 90 days after their arrival, they simply need to register within Immigration Office, providing a proof of sufficient funding and health insurance coverage.
