Additional costs	All students in Germany are required to pay a "semester contribution". What this comprises in Ilmenau is the costs of using the services of the Student Guild, the expenses incurred in the student representative system and a season ticket for the train in Thuringia. The contribution amounts in Ilmenau to the sum of 118.40 Euros for the first semester and for all followings 103.40 Euros. For accommodation students have to pay a deposit of 300 Euros.
