#### D. Additional requirements

#### P LISBOA03:

- Students have to attend at least one subject per semester, among the other courses (max. 36 ECTS credits per semester), in one of the Departments that have the Erasmus+ Agreement, according to the nomination from the sending institution.
- The stay' period of students can only be testified according to our academic calendar: 4 or 5 months for one semester and 9 months for full academic year.

#### E MADRIDO3:

- The number of students you will send to E MADRIDO3 may by no means exceed the number of students mentioned in this agreement.
   More specifically, we do not accept the mechanism by which shorter periods of stay allow for the sending of more students, i.e. on an exchange of 1 student for 10 months, you may not freely send 2 students for 5 months, not even if their stay covers different semesters. Please take this into consideration when organising your students selection.
- Complutense University has facilities for students with a learning or physical disability. - Master level students (2 nd cycle) must have passed 240 ECTS credits.- students will provide the following documents to the
  international Relations office of corresponding Faculty/School:- CV, transcript of records and motivation letter. The learning
  agreement of the student must be approved by the master's coordinator.
- Admission to a specific course is subject to the exchange student being satisfactorily qualified for the chosen area of study and/or course level, and availability

- A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. The present inter-institutional Agreement will remain valid for the period mentioned in the first page and comes into effect from the date of its signature.

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given (this means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1).
