University:

University of Zielona Góra:

A tutor program is offered for all international students for having a better start with all practical issues like opening a bank account, registrations procedures etc. ;

Language courses: Students of first cycle studies are entitled to free of charge foreign language courses (total 120 hours). University of Zielona Góra offers courses in two foreign languages English and German. Although Polish is a language of instruction at the University, several faculties offer a selection of courses taught in foreign languages, mainly in English. Polish language course for incoming students and staff is run at the Faculty of Humanities at the university. The course is run on levels ranging from A1 to C2. Participants, who attend classes, pass the final test and fulfill other conditions determined by the program of the course, will complete the course and get a relevant number of ECTS credits.

2. **Universidade Nova de Lisboa:** Students coming to the University of Universidade Nova de Lisboa, after they were nominated by their home university, are obliged to send to the Department of International Cooperation: a filled-in Application Form, the Learning Agreement, the Transcript of Records. After having received the application form the letter of admission will be send within a max. of six weeks.

University of Zielona Góra: Students coming to the University of Zielona Góra, after they were nominated by their home university, are obliged to send to the Department of International Cooperation: a filled-in Application Form, the Learning Agreement, the Transcript of Records (if required by a faculty). After having received the paper application (printed online application) the letter of admission will be send within a max. of six weeks.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. *[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]*
4. Termination of the agreement: **30th September 2021**

A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.


