RO BRASOV01:

Partner Universities will send a detailed nomination list with the beneficiaries of the Erasmus mobility, by e-mail, to erasmus@unitbv.ro, together with the required documents. The required documents will be sent by e-mail (pdf format) and the originals by post to the Erasmus Office address.

RO BRASOV01 will send to the partner institution the acceptance letter within maximum 4 weeks from the reception of the required documents, according to the information provided at http://www.unitbv.ro/orien/InternationalStudents/ErasmusStudents/Incoming.aspx.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [5] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

Transcript of Records will be issued by **RO BRASOV01** no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished, and sent by post to home institution.

4. Termination of the agreement

[In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
