Students must arrive at least 3 days before the academic year/semester starts, but not during the weekends.

Students in Bachelor and Master study programs are allowed to attend courses of maximum 63 credits/academic year and 33 credits/semester.

Staff: Teaching and non-teaching staff should send (dan.scarpete@ugal.ro) their Teaching or Training Programme prior to their arrival at the University "Dunarea de Jos" of Galati. An invitation will be released upon staff request.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks (minimum).
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

[In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

RO GALATIO1:

Students from the European Union, the European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland do not need a visa or residence permit to enter Romania. Within 90 days after their arrival, they simply need to register within Immigration Office, providing a proof of sufficient funding and health insurance coverage.

3. Insurance

All students enrolled in P LISBOA03 are covered by an accident and third party liability insurance:

- European Health Insurance Card for medical assistance (just for people from the European Union's 27 Member States plus Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland) to access health care services during temporary visits abroad
- Insurance Health for visitors outside European Union.
