- 2. The **University of Antwerp** will send its decision within 6 weeks after the application deadline, under the condition that the application is done correctly and timely.

- 3. The **University of Antwerp** as receiving institution will issue the **Transcript of Records** no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished.
 - P LISBOA03 will issue the **Transcript of Records** no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished.
- 4. Termination / modification of the agreement

Termination of the agreement or amendments in the data set above can be made annually, if communicated before 1 January. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agency can be held responsible in case of conflict.
