2. The receiving institution will send its decision within [5] weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [5] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the

exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

RO TIMISOA04: The grades are integer values from 1 to 10, with the maximal value of 10 (the highest level of knowledge and skills) and the minimal level of 5 (a basic level of knowledge is required, covering the main topics taught) for passing the examination.
